This half term in Reception we are learning through the IPC topic 'All about me'. The children will be finding out all about themselves, their new friends in the class and all of the exciting things they can do now that they are at school.

Literacy

This half term will be learning to give meaning to marks we make as we draw, write and paint.
Enjoy an increasing range of books.
Hear and says the initial sound in words.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be learning to demonstrate friendly behaviour, initiating conversations and forming good relationships with friends and familiar adults. We will begin to become confident to talk to other children when playing, and will communicate freely about own home and community.



Expressive Arts and Design

Though our art lessons we will create simple representations of events, people and objects. During our Music lessons we will begin to build a repertoire of songs and dances.

Knowledge and Understanding of the World

During Forest School we will be looking closely at similarities, differences, patterns and change. We will also be talking about enjoying joining in with family customs and routines.

Mathematics

In Maths we will begin to recognise some numerals of personal significance and the numerals 1 to 5. Practise counting up to three or four objects by saying one number name for each item.

Communication and Language

We will start to maintain our attention, concentration and learning to sit quietly during appropriate activities.

Physical Development

In our lessons we will show some understanding about good practices with regard to exercise, eating, sleeping and hygiene that can contribute to good health.
