




Nursery Overview for Spring 2019



Big Books:

So Much by Trish Cook and Dear Bear by Lucy Cousins

We know one of these books really well and the other will be new. We shall continue to look at characters in stories, settings and events but this term we shall be learning more about how stories are structured.

Other Books:

Non-fiction books from our book corner and what we can find out from them. How are they different from story books? What can we learn from them?

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We have new friends starting with us and we shall have a focus on helping them settle in and how to be good friends to them. We shall work on recognising feelings and how we are similar and different to each other.

Technology

We shall find out a bit more about turning on IT equipment, using remote controls, programming toys, and finding out information on the computer.

Maths

Number

We shall be looking at differences in quantities, introducing vocabulary like more and a lot to describe numbers and looking at the idea of numbers changing when items are added or taken away.

Shape, Space and Measure

We shall be helping the children to identify shapes in pictures and the environment and making meaningful arrangements with 2d and 3d shapes.

Exploring Media & Materials

The children will be learning more about different materials and how they can be used to make different things. They will be encouraged to change and adapt things that they make and think of different ways to do things and improve on their ideas.

When they build they will be encouraged to think about balancing and building stable structures.

We shall also be doing some baking and cake decorating and we may even have a small competition to help the children learn to listen to each others ideas and encourage teamwork.
