The Victorians



This term in year 6 we are becoming explorers learning all about the Victorian era. The teaching of this topic will be embedded in core and non-core lessons through our IPC unit: The Time Tunnel.

Literacy

In Literacy this term we will be finding out about the Victorian era through reading *Street Child* by Berlie Doherty. We plan to write locational recounts, diary entries, non-chronological reports

Numeracy

We will be looking at all things SATs! Our focus will be on problem-solving and applying our mathematical knowledge in areas such as time, shapes, angles, measures and statistics. We will also keep developing our arithmetic skills and our ability to calculate with fractions.

Humanities

Focus this term is on the Victorians inventors and social reformers who shaped our understanding of the world we live in and have made discoveries that people of the past could never have imagined. This will include: the age of steam power, significant inventions and innovations, and the work of Dr Barnardo.

Science

In science we will study evolution and inheritance and learn about the work of Charles Darwin. We will find out all about how animals are well adapted to their environments.

Creative Arts/DT

Our focus will be on Victorian art and we will look at Lowry and his work on depicting street scenes as well William Morris prints. In DT we will be exploring texture (textiles, clay, sand, plaster, stone). This will be linked into the work we do on William Morris,

PE/Dance:

In dance this term we will be focusing on different dance styles including Charleston and Street.
