

Year 3: Summer Term

Explorers and Adventurers



This term in Year 3 we are becoming explorers and learning all about the great adventurers of the past and present. The teaching of this topic will be embedded in core and non-core lessons through our IPC unit: Explorers and Adventurers.

Literacy

In Literacy this term we will be studying 3 short stories: *Little People, Big Dreams*; Harriet Tubman, *Little People, Big Dreams*; Greta Thunberg, and *Quill Soup* by Alan Durant. We plan to write biographical recounts, letters, and stories based on the people we will learn about and their lives.

Numeracy

This term in maths we will focus on fractions. We will spend time recapping the basic building blocks of fractions and new skills will be embedded within continuous problem solving and number work.

Science

In science we will be exploring the force of magnetism, as well as the sun and shadows and finding out how explorers used these things to help them navigate around the Earth.



Computing

This term in computing we are **Coding**. This will enable the children to think carefully about coding the algorithms needed to create a successful educational game.

Humanities

Focus this term is on the great explorers who shaped our understanding of the world we live in and have made discoveries that people of the past could never have imagined. This will include: the age of exploration, space and deep sea adventurers to name a few.

Creative Arts

Focus will be on the work of the explorer artists, who ventured out on great expeditions and recorded what they saw using pencil and paint. These include: Margaret Mee, Charles Darwin and George Caitlin.

PE/Dance:

In dance this term we will be focusing on different dance styles including Charleston and Street.
