
Year 3: Summer Term

Explorers and Adventurers





Literacy

In Literacy this term we will be studying 3 short stories: Little People, Big Dreams; Harriet Tubman, Little People, Big Dreams; Greta Thunberg, and Quill Soup by Alan Durant. We plan to write biographical recounts, letters, and stories based on the people we will learn about and their lives.



This term in maths we will focus on fractions. We will spend time recapping the basic building blocks of fractions and new skills will be embedded within continuous problem solving and number work.



Computing

This term in computing we are Coding. This will enable the children to think carefully about coding the algorithms needed to create a successful educational game.

Humanities

Focus this term is on the great explorers who shaped our understanding of the world we live in and have made discoveries that people of the past could never have imagined. This will include: the age of exploration, space and deep sea adventurers to name a few

Science

In science we will be exploring the force of magnetism, as well as the sun and shadows and finding out how explorers used these things to help them navigate around the Earth.
